## PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

### **Community-based Program for Children and Families (Malihao, Sta. Mesa, CPC Areas)**

- Child Protection Clinic on Wheels – a community based advocacy for the protection of children which provide help desks for counseling, learning sessions, family life enrichments, formation of child and community grassroots advocates.
- Community Mobilization for Education (COME) Project in Negros Occidental - a direct social protection program to reduce the vulnerability of children from hazardous labor and exploitation in the sugar producing communities.
- Formation Program for Children-at-Risk - direct service intervention for the protection of children from high risk behaviours through educational assistance, values education, and socio-cultural activities.
- Vocational/ Technical Education Program – a direct service intervention program for youth at risk to acquire skills for job placement and self-sustained entrepreneurship.
- Post-disaster Response Program – provision of relief and recovery, psychosocial support, medical assistance and family life enrichment.
- Youth Helping Youth (YEHEY) Program – an innovation of LVF

### **Residential Program for Sexually Abused Girls**

- a home-based program for protective custody, healing and recovery of sexually abused, exploited and trafficked girls that aims to rebuild and transform their lives to become healthy survivors.
- Group Home for Independent Living – a facility for the social preparation of children who have undergone healing and recovery and are ready for eventual independent living.
